Here is an update on what is going on at your radio station.

- Bill Prendergast visited KSDP this past week and installed Natural Music. The program will dramatically improve are music rotation. Already, you can hear a big change on the air. Bill also fixed the automation system so that NPR news fires perfectly at the top of every hour.
- The radio station will have a high speed internet connection from the University of Alaska Fairbanks via satellite. The equipment needed to make this link is here in Sand Point and we are organizing a technical visit from Alaska Public Broadcasting for the installation. The engineering visit will be covered by a grant the station received a while back from the State of Alaska.
- We are making a grant proposal to the Denali Commission to improve the radio station's offices and studios. If this is approved, we could receive as much as one hundred thousand dollars and the money could be used to relocate the station to a building that the radio station purchased.
