## A Message From The Principal

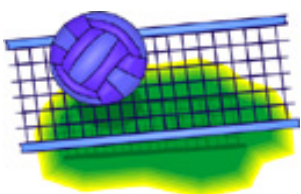

### News from the Kindergarten Classroom

The kindergarten class has had great success this week utilizing the Promethean Activeboard in the classroom. The students loved the interactive flip charts where they could perform hands on activities as they learned about patterns, rhyming words, and their five senses. For patterns, the student could click and drag colors, shapes, and even farm animals as they continued patterns and made their own patterns. For rhyming words, students added beginning sounds to certain word families such as an to make words that rhyme such as ran, can, fan, etc. For the five senses, students were able to click and drag pictures to make a graph matching the body part (eyes, ears, nose, tongue, and hands) with something that it senses (see, hear, smell, taste, and feel) such as a rainbow would go in the eyes column.

This is a great way to integrate technology with math, language arts, and science as well as additional content areas. The Activeboard is also a great tool to have in the classroom to use learning web sites in an interactive, whole class setting. The students enjoy taking turns using the active pen and answering questions. It is such a fun way for them to learn.
