A Message From The Principal

Next week, April 2, 3, 4, 5, are the important Standards Based Assessments (SBAs) and High School Graduation Qualifying Exams (HSGQE). Please help support the testing effort by considering the following helpful tips.

Help your student do his or her best!

- o Make sure your child gets plenty of rest the night before the test.
- o Make sure your child attends school on testing days and get him/her there on time. Avoid scheduling other appointments that day. Missed HSGQE tests can not be made up.
- o Feed your student a good breakfast the day of the test and be positive when he/she leaves for school. (Breakfast is also being served at the school on the mornings of testing.)
- o Encourage your child. Let your child know you think he/she will do well on the test. Remind him/her to relax and focus on the test.

If you have any questions regarding the High School Graduation Qualifying Exam or the Standard Based Assessment, please contact your School Principal or the District Test Coordinator.

The bus time and the start and dismissal for school will remain the same. Breakfast will be served from 8:15 to 9:10 with testing beginning at 9:00 for grades 7-10 students and 9:30 for grade 3-6 students. Late arrivals will not be admitted to a test already in session. Breaks are worked into the testing day and snacks will be provided for students in grades 3-10.

*Absences: If your student (3rd through 9th) is absent they can make up their est the following week. If your student is a 10th grader and is absent on a testing day, there is NO make up for the HSGQE. Students will need to wait until next fall to retest.

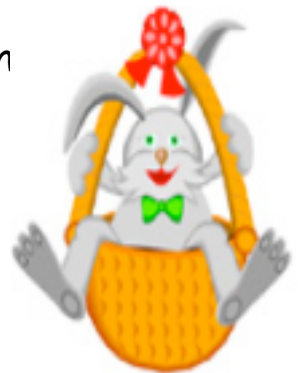
