The ALEUTIANS EAST BOROUGH SCHOOL DISTRICT is pleased to announce our participation in the National School Lunch Program for the 2014-2015 school year. Meals will be available to all children at the following district schools: KING COVE SCHOOL and SAND POINT SCHOOL. Meals meet nutritional standards set by the U.S. Department of Agriculture. These two schools will participate in the National School Lunch Program (NSLP) and beginning this school year, in the School Breakfast Program (SBP).

Additionally, we are pleased to inform you that the King Cove and Sand Point Schools of the Aleutians East Borough School District will be implementing a new provision this 2014-2015 school year, available to schools participating in the NSLP and SBP called the Community Eligibility Provision (CEP).

WHAT IS CEP? All enrolled students of the King Cove or Sand Point Schools of the Aleutians East Borough School District are eligible to receive at school each day, a healthy breakfast and lunch, as defined by the USDA – at NO CHARGE – during the 2014-2015 school year.

No further action is required. Students will be able to participate in these meal programs without having to pay a fee or submit a meal program application.

The Aleutians East Borough School District receives additional federal funding from Title I grants and E-rate program discounts. To be eligible for this necessary and important financial assistance, the district must collect data similar to that obtained in past years through the Free and Reduced Price School Meals application and/or the Migrant Education application. As these application processes are not required for CEP participation, we will need the E-rate survey form completed and submitted, along with the Migrant Education application, if applicable. The 2-page E-rate survey form and Migrant Education application will be included with the school enrollment forms package.
