

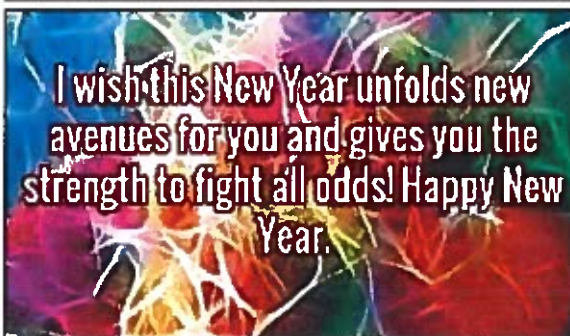


Thank You!!! FAA - SDP

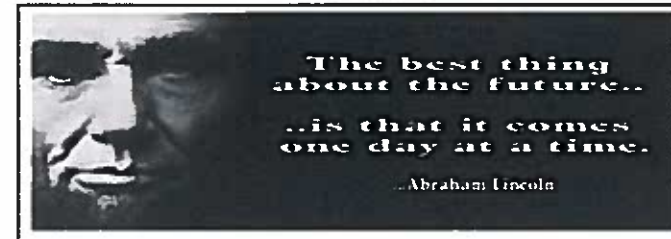


Alex at the State Tournament

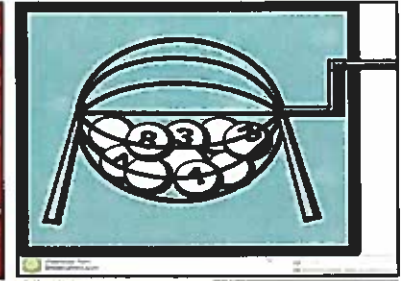
