_____ is our Caught Being Good student of the week.

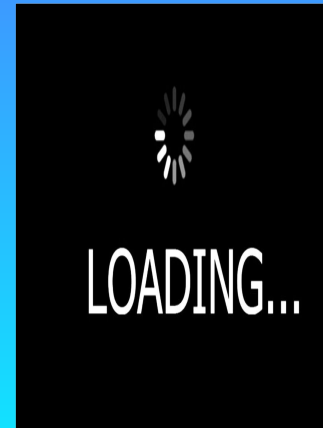

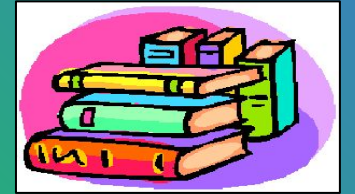
Eagle of the Week

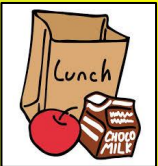
