This last year we were given a line item in our Boroughs budget with the focus of expanding our coverage within our region and beginning new opportunities for teaching our students. We are working to establish a curriculum opportunity for journalism with the English departments in our two main schools. We work with the school to help set up sound and improve the quality of the community wide productions, we have continued to broadcast nearly every sporting event and basketball game for our schools and as previously stated we are creating new technical opportunities to teach networking and radio to our students. We have hosted our communities 4th of July event for the past 5 or 6 years, and this year we made it a complete fundraiser opportunity for our rising junior class to help fund their trip to Washington, D.C for the Close-Up program. Finally, we continue to broadcast and archive all of our city council meetings, Borough Assembly and School District meetings for our constituents to use.

We commonly receive phone calls and during my time in the community people often refer back to the radio station for information about what is happening in the community. When it comes to measurable levels of success, it is difficult in a community our size (2500 people spread over several hundred miles with no connecting roads between communities) to give a quantitative metric for success, but we have been approached by 2 new communities to start radio stations, we have increased our underwriting participation and municipal giving by several factors over the past several years, and we can see that people do stream online and visit our website/Facebook page at a consistent rate. I can say we are consistently referenced for information and given announcement and news to announce. As I said, this is hard to quantify, but the continued and even increasing level of engagement with our media content, it shows the impact Aleutian Peninsula Broadcasting continues to have.

Our main minority focus is for Alaskan-Native as the majority of our resident listeners are tribal members. We offer several programs that focus on this important cultural feature, and we are always trying to do whatever we can to promote cultural identity and empowerment. There is migrant worker component to our village based on the fish processing community in our town. It is literally like a second town within our village and it exists on essentially a separate plane. We have not found a solid way to engage this group, but we are open to considering how we could do this.
